



Passenger Code of Conduct

IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY, WHILE TRAVELLING ON TASSIELINK TRANSIT:

(1) A person on a public passenger vehicle must not –

- (a) smoke; or
- (b) litter.

(2) A person on a public passenger vehicle must not –

- (a) do anything to endanger the safety of the vehicle or another person; or
- (b) threaten, harass or attempt to intimidate another person; or
- (c) unreasonably obstruct or hinder another person; or
- (d) unreasonably disturb the comfort or convenience of another person; or
- (e) damage or deface the vehicle or any of the vehicle's fittings or the property of another person; or
- (f) throw anything inside, or from, the vehicle.

(3) A person who is a passenger on a public passenger vehicle providing a regular passenger transport service must not, without the permission of the driver or an authorised person –

- (a) travel without a valid ticket for the journey being undertaken; or
- (b) eat or drink; or
- (c) occupy more than one seat; or
- (d) sell or distribute, or attempt to sell or distribute, anything; or
- (e) display, or attempt to display, any sign; or
- (f) affix, or attempt to affix, anything to the vehicle; or
- (g) have an animal on board the vehicle.
